Subject: Young Marine Program Re-registration

I hope that your Young Marine has enjoyed our activities during the last year. In addition, I hope that you've seen some growth in maturity from your Young Marine as well as the physical growth that has taken place. We will continue to challenge our Young Marines in the coming year with interesting programs and challenging activities in keeping with our motto of "Strengthening the Lives of America's Youth."

The Young Marine program operates on a fiscal year of October 1 through September 30. Therefore, at the beginning of the fiscal year, Young Marines must re-register to continue in the program. It is time now to begin that re-registration. During re-registration, our unit also updates emergency contact and medical information for each Young Marine. National Headquarters has set the registration fee at \$20.00, which we must collect from each Young Marine and Adult Leader to send on to National Headquarters. This is the only expense associated with registration.

Please follow these instructions on the re-registration forms for each Young Marine you are re-registering. Fill in all information on each form. Please print. All information must be legible.

The **YM MED FORM 4, Physical Examination** must be completed by a physician (a physical done so that he/she can play school athletics in 2011 will suffice) if:

- a. your child graduated boot camp before 2011, or
- b. your child completed boot camp in 2011 and his or her physical condition has not changed, another one will not be necessary.

Bring all completed forms as well as \$20.00 cash or a \$20 check payable to the Young Marines to drill on **20 August** or mail the check to Barbara Tassej (700 Irwin Road, Powell TN 37849) before **10 September**.

If your Young Marine has decided not to re-register in the Young Marines, return his or her gear at our drill on **24 September** at Eagleton Elementary School. If you paid a uniform deposit and all uniform items and gear are returned (excluding the red Young Marine t-shirts – you keep those), we will check to determine if you are entitled to a partial refund in accordance with the guidelines in the "Uniform Fee Deposit Policy" you received during your Young Marine's Recruit Training.
